## Where can I get the latest FLEXLM utilities for the AWRDE

You can get the Windows FLEXIm utilities from various locations including:

- Download the full set of Cadence Windows License Utilities: https://downloads.cadence.com/ (Click on the Windows section and find the download Lic+Config\_Utils)
- Download flex version 11.19.1.0 from here to download without a login: FLEXIm Utilities Download.

These utilities are used for setting up floating licenses, debugging floating license installations, and installing hardware key drivers.

FLEXIm utilities are backward-compatible, so the latest version of the flex tools and daemons on the AWR website works for all\* versions of the AWRDE.

To use a floating license server with V16 of the AWR Design Environment you must use >= v11.14.1.0 of the cdsImd daemon

To use a floating license server with V15 and earlier versions of the AWR Design Environment, you must use >= v11.15.1.0 of the awrd daemon.

\*all - meaning all version of the AWR Design Environment that use the awrd daemon. AWR began using the awrd daemon in AWR V7.0 in the year 2004.

## How to update old FLEXLM utilities

- 1. Stop the server. Start the current Imtools.exe. Go to Start/Stop/Reread tab, select your AWR server and click Stop Server button. You can use the command line syntax if you are familiar with them.
- Replace the old FlexIm files with the new ones. These files are located in \Windows\Flex\_Tools folder after you unzip the FLEXIm Utilities Download.
- 3. Start Imtools.exe
- Go to Config Services tab and make sure everything looks good. The new Imtools always pick up the setting from the old one but double check to make sure.
- 5. Start the server from Start/Stop/Reread tab
